


Specifications:

- Duration: 1 hr 15 mins 2 hrs
- Participants: 3 18
- Environment: face-to-face, Zoom or Teams



ASPEDRAN – collect <u>A</u>ll ideas of all participants




- 1. Ask participants to write 1-2 sentence ideas to the text editor. Target is to get 25 – 80 ideas.
- 2. Set the timer to show users how much time they have.

Duration: 5 – 10 minutes




ASPEDRAN – <u>Select interesting</u> thoughts



- Ask everyone to drag interesting ideas to the empty area on the top right the create a group.
 Guideline is to select 25 35 % ideas to 3 6 groups.
- 2. Users can give names for the groups
- 3. Give about 3 6 minutes for this. Use the timer.
- 4. You can use pairs or trios in breakouts for discussing the topic and agreeing who writes about which topic. Users can share the groups to their pair with *Share*.. Duration about 5-10 minutes, use also the timer



ASPEDRAN – create Proposals



- 1. Ask participants to move to *Create*
- 2. Ask participants to write a proposals based on the selected ideas now visible on the left. Each solution should have about 5 lines.
- 3. Here are guidelines for the number of proposals


Participants Proposals / participant

3 - 5	5 -
6 – 7	4
8 – 10	3
Over 10	2

Duration: 10 - 20 minutes




ASPEDRAN – <u>Explain</u>, <u>Develop and</u> Rank



- 1. Ask everyone to move to Develop
- Everyone presents each of their proposals in 1 minute
- You as facilitator can highlight the proposal by clicking on the pin icon.
- During presentation, everyone posts their development comments.
- 5. After presentations everyone has 10 minutes to continue commenting the most interesting proposals.
- 6. You can ask the participants to prioritize the proposals by liking the best proposals.



ASPEDRAN – <u>A</u>lignment and <u>N</u>ext steps



- 1. Move to *Group*
- Only you as the facilitator can group and align proposals by dragging and dropping them based on participants' suggestions
- 3. Proposals without votes can be leaved out of grouping.
- 4. When proposals are grouped, the groups can be named based on participants' suggestions.
- 5. For the next steps also names of responsible person can be added to the headline of the grouped group.
- 6. Results can be printed in Word –document and add to that more accurate next steps



ASPEDRAN – Next steps in Word



- 1. Next steps can be added by the facilitator to the Worddocument. Worddocument can be exported from the Workshop list on the main page of Orchidea Workshop by clicking the three dots on the right-hand side of the workshop name.
- There is dedicated place for next steps in the end of each set of grouped proposals.
