
# 9. WetoMe

#### Specifications:

- Duration: 1 hr 15 mins 2 hrs
- Participants: 4 40
- Environment: face-to-face, Teams or Zoom




#### WetoMe - collect



- 1. Ask participants to write at least 5-sentence insights related to the topic to the text editor.
- 2. Set the timer to show users how much time they have. Give about 15 minutes
- 3. Collect -phase may be optionally completed also as prework




#### WetoMe - vote



- 1. Ask participants to move to *Select*
- 2. Ask everyone to select the best insights. Give criteria for voting and the number of votes per participant (15 25 % of total idea count)
- 3. Show how to sort the ideas based on popularity by choosing Filter & Sort => Sort: Most selected
- 4. Set the timer on, give 5 15 minutes to this phase



### WetoMe - select




- Ask everyone to choose one of the top insight for developing personal next steps
- 2. Everyone drags the chosen insight to empty area on the top right. Same insight can be chosen by many participants.
- 3. Chosen idea can be complimented by dragging supporting ideas to the same group

Duration: 3 - 5 minutes




#### WetoMe - create



- 1. Ask everyone to move to *Create*
- 2. Ask participants to write personal next steps based on the selected insights now visible on the left
- Ask participants to answer also the sub-questions that you added after creating the workshop. One of the subquestions should be action oriented like "What will be your concrete next steps?"
- 4. Give about 10-20 minutes time. Set the timer on.
- 5. Optional pair discussion can take place before this phase to give participants new perspectives to their idea



## WetoMe - develop



- 1. Ask everyone to move to Develop
- 2. Everyone presents their next steps in 2-3 minutes for 4 5 persons breakout group
- During presentation, everyone posts their development comments.
- 4. After presentations everyone has 10 20 minutes to commenting the proposals of all participants.
- 5. Finally, everyone incorporates the comments by editing his action plan.
